WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU: Proof of identity (driver license, State ID card, or passport); social security card for you/your spouse and or SSN verification letter; birth dates for you, your spouse, and dependents; Any form W-2, W-2G, 1099-R from all employers for you/your spouse; current year tax package if you received one; interest and dividend statements from banks (forms 1099); a copy of your/your spouse's last year federal and state returns if you have them; bank routing numbers and account number for direct deposit of your refund; records for total paid to any day care provider and that person's SSN or business EIN; if filing jointly, your spouse must be present to sign the forms
